Acceptable Use Policy - Technology

The Indian Community School of Milwaukee desires to provide its students with the technological tools necessary for them to take their places in a world that is becoming increasingly technologically based. The classrooms in our school should reflect the changing face of information exchange in our country and world. Instruction will be delivered in a manner utilizing current technology wherever possible. The integration of technology and the classroom will be the emphasis of the instruction of both the computer teacher and the classroom teacher.

Technology is more than just the computers in the classrooms and the many learning tools provided for Indian Community School (ICS) students; therefore, all students and staff will understand and practice proper and ethical use of all the tools. The rules will be clearly explained at the beginning of the school year and posted in the classrooms as a reminder.

1. Acceptable Use

The purpose of the Internet is to facilitate research and education by providing access to unique resources and an opportunity for collaborative work. To remain eligible as a user, the user of the account must follow the following rules:

- I will not give my account name or password, if I have one, to any other student.
- I will never give my name, my home address, my telephone number or any personal information about me or my family or friends, to anyone I write to or talk with on the Internet
- I will not enter anything in the computer that contains ugly or rude language or pictures.
- I will not try to go to Internet sites that have inappropriate pictures or words. If I accidentally go to a site that has information that I think should not be seen by students, I will tell my teacher right away and not show it to other students.
- If I use information from the Internet in a report, I will make sure that I follow the rules my teacher gives for documenting my sources of information.
- I will not deliberately harm a computer, computer software, or the computer network.
- I will not use the Internet or school computers for non-school related activities.
- I will not use the Internet to buy or sell, or to attempt to buy or sell any service or product.

- I will not place unlawful information on the Internet or use the Internet illegally in any way that violates federal, state, or local laws or statutes

2. Privilege

The use of the Internet is a privilege, not a right. Inappropriate use, including any violation of the rules stated above, may result in my losing the privilege to use computers.
